Increasing the temperature of the solution increases its solubility. More solute can be dissolved because the particles are moving faster, which increases the number of collisions between solute and solvent particles. Supersaturated solutions are made by increasing the temperature of the solution. Pressure affects the solubility of gaseous solutes.
